Acolytes: On this First Sunday of Lent, we are re-instituting the ancient Christian tradition of employing acolytes at Trinity Presbyterian. Our English word acolyte is derived from the Greek word "akolouthos" meaning companion, attendant, or helper. Within Scripture, the tradition and roots of acolyting can be traced back to the young prophet Samuel serving as a helper to Eli. In our worship tradition, the lighting of the candles at the beginning of the worship service symbolizes bringing the light of Christ into our midst. The extinguishing of the candles and carrying out the light at the conclusion of our worship reminds us that we are to carry the light of Jesus out into the world. We are blessed to have youth who want to be active participants in our worship! We welcome their return to our service!

New Wednesday Night Adult Bible Study- "The Lord's Prayer in Aramaic," begins on March 13th at 6:30pm. 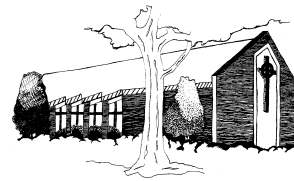

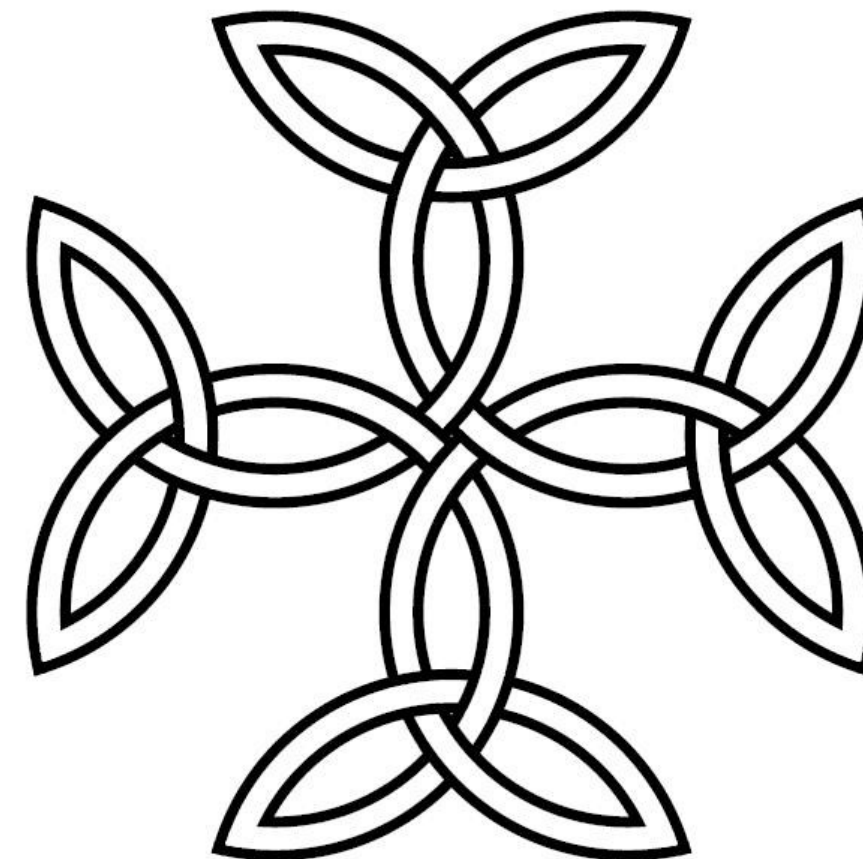
